## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

ACER initiates the procedure Ref. ACER-MIT-2021-001 for requesting, by decision, from BSP Energetska Borza d.o.o., CROPEX Ltd, EirGrid plc, EPEX Spot SE, GME Spa, HEnEx SA, HUPX Zrt., Independent Bulgarian Power Exchange (IBEX), Nord Pool SA, OKTE a.s., OMIE S.A., OPCOM S.A., OTE a.s., SONI Ltd, and Towarowa Gielda Energii S.A. (hereinafter SIDC NEMOs) the necessary information to effectively monitor the European wholesale market's integrity and transparency according to Article 3(2) of Regulation (EU) No. 2019/942<sup>1</sup>, Articles 7 and 8 of Regulation (EU) No. 1227/2011 (REMIT), and Article 6(8) of REMIT Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 1348/2014.

The requested information relates to the Single Intraday Coupling (SIDC) market. More specifically, it is necessary for the reconstruction of the trading dynamic and the local view of the Shared Order Book in SIDC. As such, this information is essential for ACER's compliance with its mandate to monitor the wholesale energy markets pursuant to Article 7 of REMIT. The requested data is intended to complement the data collected according to Article 8 of REMIT on SIDC.

ACER expects to decide on the subject matter by the end of **January 2022**.
