

Public notice

ACER initiates the procedures ref. ACER-ELE-2022-006, ACER-ELE-2022-007 and ACER-ELE-2022-008 for amendments of the mFRR, aFRR and IN Implementation Frameworks pursuant to, respectively, Article 20, 21 and 22 of Regulation (EU) 2017/2195.

On 31 March 2022, all TSOs submitted to ACER their proposals for amendments of the mFRR, aFRR and IN Implementation Frameworks pursuant to, respectively, Article 20, 21 and 22 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing ('EB Regulation').

According to Articles 5(2)(a) and 6(3) of the EB Regulation, ACER shall decide on this matter within 6 months, i.e. by 30 September 2022.

In order to inform its assessment, ACER invites interested third parties to submit their observations on the proposals during a four-week public consultation between 16 May and 12 June 2022.

Following this consultation, ACER will consider stakeholder feedback and expects to take a decision on the proposals for amendments within the above mentioned deadline, i.e. by 30 September 2022.
