Updated methodological note for the Country Assessment Sheets ('CASs')

- (1) This methodological note for the assessment of CASs in the fourth Agency's Report substantially relies on the one presented in the Technical Annex II¹ of the second Agency's Report. Therefore, the present note only focusses on the changes to that methodology. For further details on the unchanged elements of the methodology, we refer the reader to the aforementioned document.
- (2) The differences compared to the already adopted methodology take stock of the changed implementation background, at the end of the interim measure phase. Indeed, the changed mostly refer to the evaluation of the application of interim measures, the use of balancing services, and balancing platforms ('BP'). Table 1 includes all changes applied to the previously adopted methodology.
