	The corrigendum updates data on retail prices for electricity and gas consumers in the household and industrial segment for the year 2015.  All the changes are set out below.	

#### Changes from Original to Corrigendum version (March 2017)

All the changes (indicated in *italics*) introduced vis-à-vis version 1 are listed below by heading number and title of version 1.

#### 3 Retail energy prices

The first two sentences of the third paragraph on page 8 changed, as follows:
