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The Board of Appeal dismissed an appeal brought against ACER Decision

on the Implementation framework for a European platform for the exchange of balancing energy from frequency restoration reserves with automatic activation (Decision No. 02/2020)

On 23 March 2020, the Board of Appeal received appeals brought by Austrian Power Grid AG, ČEPS a.s., Independent Power Transmission Operator S.A., Polskie Sieci Elektroenergetyczne, Red Eléctrica de España, S.A., Réseau de Transport d'Électricité, Affärsverket svenska kraftnät, TenneT TSO GmbH and TenneT TSO B.V. seeking the revision or annulment of Decision No. 02/2020 of the European Union Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators of 24 January 2020 on the Implementation framework for a European platform for the exchange of balancing energy from frequency restoration reserves with automatic activation. The appeals have been consolidated and registered under case number A-001-2020 (consolidated).

After careful consideration of the merits and hearing of the parties, the Board of Appeal found the appeals unfounded. The non-confidential version of the final decision of the Board of Appeal is published on the website of the Agency on 19 August 2020.
