Webinar Objective: As part of its monitoring obligations, ACER must identify any barriers to the completion of the internal markets for electricity and natural gas. ACER is organising a webinar to present the conclusions of its 2023 Market Monitoring Reports published in July 2023, which contribute to that goal:

- Assessment of emergency measures in electricity markets; and
- Cross-zonal capacities and the margin available for cross-zonal electricity trade (MACZT).

With this online event, ACER intends to:

- Present the main conclusions of each report;
- Discuss these conclusions with a panel of experts;
- Address stakeholders' questions and gather views from stakeholders regarding the findings.

ACER is running a <u>public consultation</u> (21 July – 15 September 2023) on its report on cross-zonal capacities and the margin available for cross-zonal electricity trade (MACZT). Based on its findings, ACER will issue a formal opinion with recommendations to the European Commission and European Parliament by the end of the year.
