**Webinar Objective:** ACER will present the achievements and possible improvements of the Capacity Allocation Mechanisms Network Code (CAM NC), based on its monitoring activities, opinions, decisions, joint ACER-ENTSOG FUNC issue solutions and other publications.

Stakeholders will have the opportunity to bring forth their views and inform ACER's review of the CAM NC, in particular identifying further areas of improvement.

As a follow up to this workshop and the inputs received in the public consultation, ACER intends to publish a policy paper, tentatively in the first quarter of 2024. This policy paper will be a first input when the formal review of the CAM NC may be launched in the course of 2024.
