Dear Madam, Sir,

Fortum appreciate the opportunity given by ACER to give feedback on the discussion paper on disclosure of inside information.

We strongly agree with the Agency's view, as described in section 3 of the discussion paper. Public regional platforms for disclosure of inside information would be the most efficient way forward, and thus **Fortum supports the option A proposed**. Our experience of the regional Urgent Market Message service maintained by Nord Pool Spot is very good, and moreover the UMM application is about to be totally renewed with additional features for presenting aggregated data on reported unavailability.

The planned Entso-E transparency platform should collect and present data from the regional platforms, for both fundamental data and inside information, and thus constitute the overall information publication platform on European level – and at the same time be the main source for the Agency to collect data from.

However, there should be a distinction between data that should be made public and data that only should be reported to the Agency for surveillance purpose.
